## **Standing Reports**

A. Events/Fundraising – Rebecca O'Brien

- Chris Parente has offered to spearhead a new idea, "30 under 40". This is an idea to help engage the younger crowd. 30 volunteers under age of 40 would be asked to host a party/event for any people (party attendees not demographic specific). The goal would be to raise \$1000 per party/event. We could possibly promote this at Time of Your Life, and get people to at least pledge to host. This idea is completely separate from Time of Your Life. It is meant to get people together.
- Time of Your Life website will be developed, along with a video.

### B. Social Justice - Amir Rafizadeh and Lina Hilko

- Health Amir is organizing a CPR/Health training for parishioners, and others who may be interested.
- Food Pantry
  - New volunteer information site has launched
  - We should look into gaining a volunteer database, so that if we are short on volunteers, we have a quick place to find others
  - How can we get more volunteers? Possibly sign them up on iPads after mass
  - Hunger walk is June 21<sup>st</sup>. For anyone that participates, we get \$12 worth of groceries (babies count too).
  - Loaves and Fishes has been approved to get Chicago Food Depository assistance
    - Now that we are approved, everyone should take the sanitation class that Tom and Amir had to attend.
    - Moving forward, all cook volunteers will need to wear gloves and hair nets.
- Haiti
  - Rally campaign raised \$10k
  - Anna has stepped down a bit from liaison work
  - Christine reached out to Parking Lot Party planners to ask for space to display children's art work
  - Fr. Frank updated that he will start to recommend that the Haiti project seek perhaps a better fit or larger parish to work within for more effectiveness.
